What is Governance?



Governance is a system that directs, oversees, and holds an organisation accountable for achieving its defined purpose in an ethical and responsible manner.

- ISO 37 000

Corporate governance focuses on how companies are directed, governed, and controlled. It defines relationships between a company's management, its board, its shareholders, and other stakeholders.

- European Commission and International Finance Corporation

Corporate governance guides how a company is directed and its relationships with its shareholders and stakeholders.

- Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (USA)

Governance encompasses the system by which an organisation is controlled and operates, and the mechanisms by which it, and its people, are held to account. Ethics, risk management, compliance and administration are all elements of governance.

- Governance Institute of Australia

A framework of rules, relationships, systems, and processes by which authority is exercised and controlled in corporations

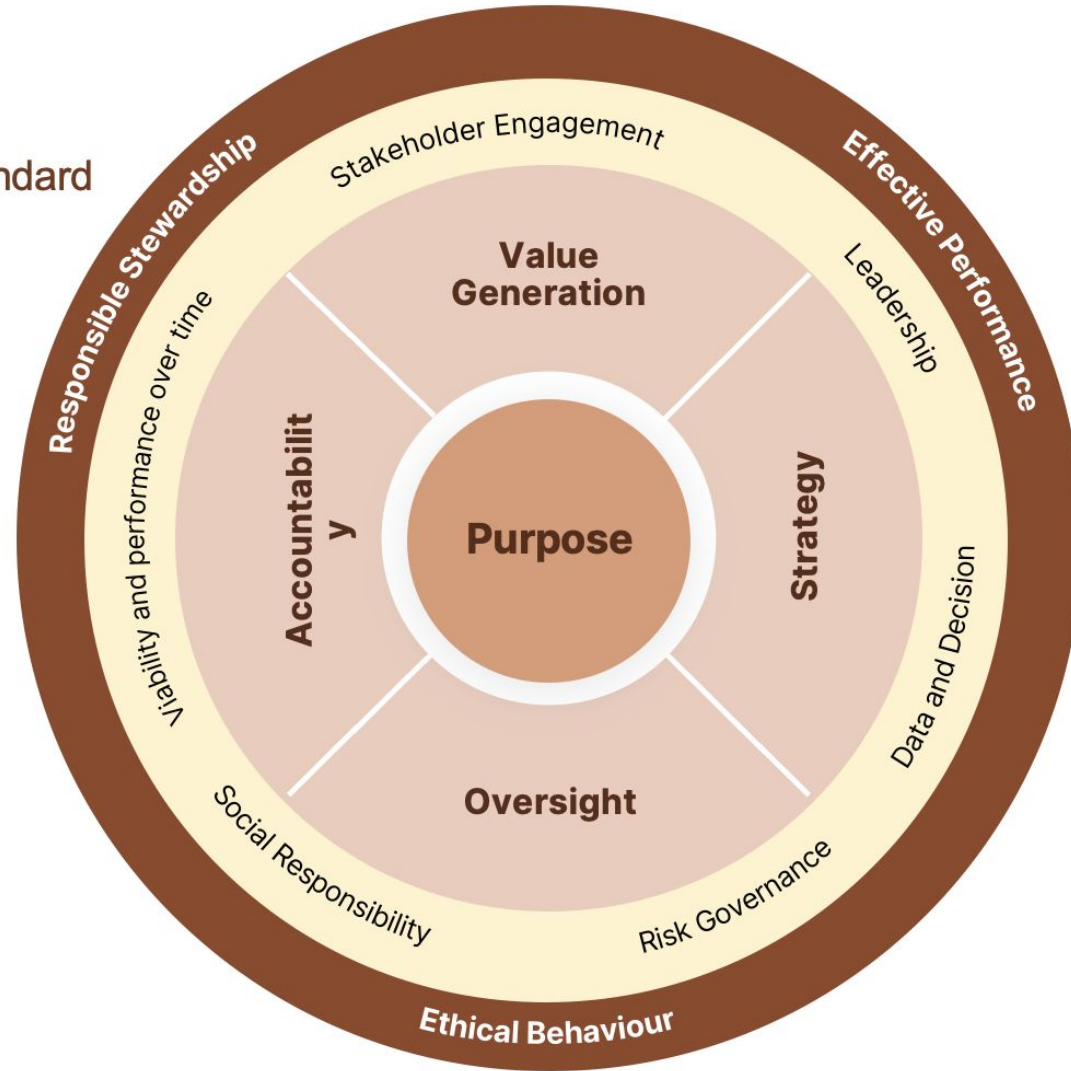

ISO 37000:2021

Governance of Organisations – a Global Standard

ISO 37000:2021: *Governance of organizations – Guidance* was developed by the ISO technical committee ISO/TC 309. Governance of organizations, whose secretariat is held by the BSI, the ISO National standards Body for the UK.

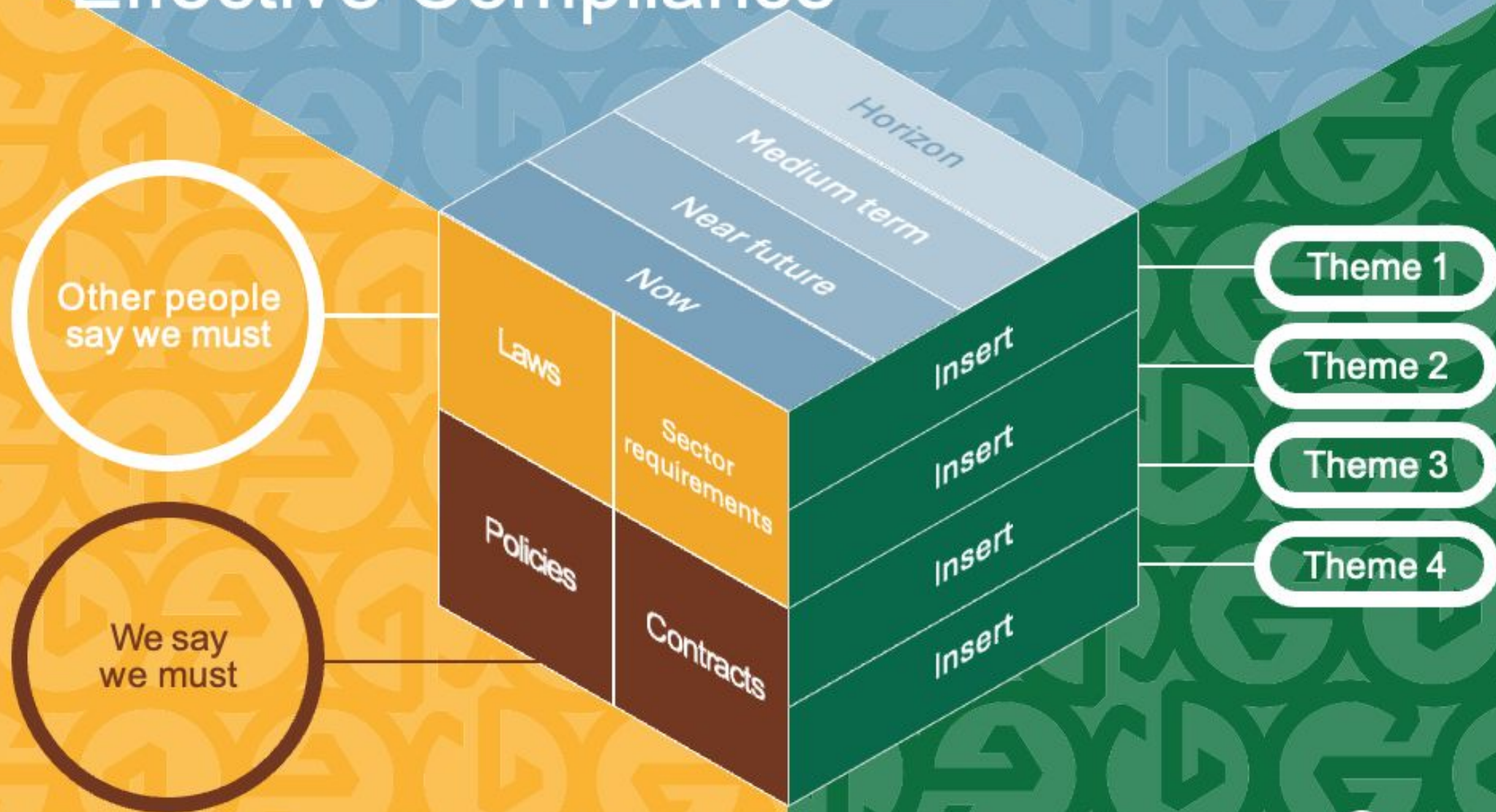
The Role of the Chair – A Global Perspective

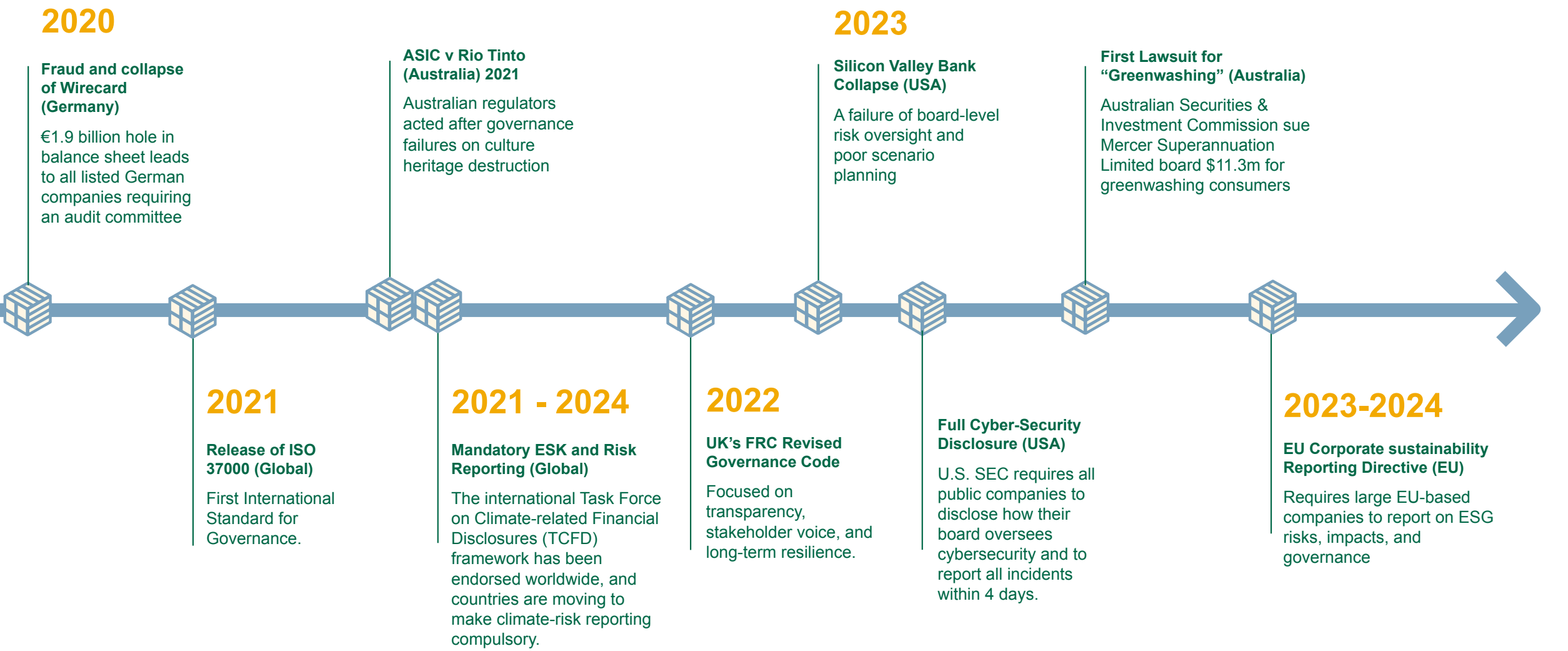
